Help Your Child Pick an Appropriate Costume

- Choose only fire-retardant materials for your child's costume
- Avoid costumes with masks, wigs, hats or eye patches that block vision.
- Choose bright, reflective clothing or a reflective patch or tape attached to your child's costume & candy bag
- Knives, swords & other accessories should be made from cardboard or flexible materials instead of plastic, metal, or wood
- Costumes should be short enough to prevent your child from tripping or falling
- ❖Make sure your child wears well-fitting, sturdy shoes
